During the Stroke Summer School you are cordially invited to participate in exciting social activities.

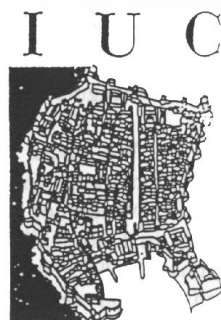
